2 To commend the Peabody Magnet High School boys' basketball team on winning the
3 Louisiana High School Athletic Association 2024 Division II Select state
4 championship.

5 WHEREAS, the Peabody Magnet High School Warhorses captured the 2024
6 Division II Select state title by defeating Madison Prep, 43-40, in overtime in the
7 championship game held at Burton Coliseum in Lake Charles, Louisiana; and

8 WHEREAS, the Peabody boys' basketball program, which finished the season with
9 twenty-eight wins and only five losses, now owns its tenth state title; Coach Charles Smith
10 earned his tenth title as well, winning nine as head coach and one as an assistant; he was also
11 recently named as a finalist for the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield,
12 Massachusetts; and

13 WHEREAS, Jordan Mathews was named the Most Outstanding Player of the title
14 game after scoring twelve points and securing fourteen rebounds; additionally, Zaydrien
15 Sewell secured the victory by draining a clutch go-ahead three-point shot with less than ten
16 seconds left in overtime; and

17 WHEREAS, the Peabody Magnet High School Warhorses are most deserving of the
18 highest recognition for their incredible determination during the title game and for earning
19 the program's tenth state championship.

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
