Abstract: Provides relative to preemption of state law pertaining to firearms.

Present law provides that no governing authority of a political subdivision shall enact after July 15, 1985, any ordinance or regulation more restrictive than state law concerning in any way the sale, purchase, possession, ownership, transfer, transportation, license, or registration of firearms, ammunition, or components of firearms or ammunition.

Proposed law retains present law and provides that no governing authority of a political subdivision shall enact after July 15, 1985, or enforce any ordinance, order, regulation, policy, procedure, rule, or any other form of executive or legislative action more restrictive than state law.

Proposed law further provides that any ordinance, order, or regulation, policy, procedure, rule, or any other form of executive or legislative action cannot be more restrictive than state law regarding the manufacture, carrying, storage, taxation, firearm accessories, knives, edged weapons, or any combination thereof.
