Abstract: Prohibits speeding violations from being issued via unmanned automated speed enforcement devices under certain circumstances.

Present law prohibits authorities from installing automated speed enforcement devices on interstate roadways within their territorial limits.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law provides an exception to present law for Dept. of Transportation construction zones except for local municipal authorities and local parish authorities.

Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law adds a prohibition for imposition of speeding violations within a school zone via unmanned automated speed enforcement devices when the driver is not exceeding the posted speed limit immediately prior to the school zone if speed limit signs are not posted at the entrance and exit of the school zone.
