1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "website" and before "and" insert a semi-colon ";"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 20 and insert the following:

6 "B. The board shall annually adopt a report to the House and Governmental
7 Affairs Committee of the House of Representatives and the Senate and
8 Governmental Affairs Committee of the Senate its of findings, observations, and
9 recommendations concerning all aspects of elections in this state. The report shall
10 be submitted no later than January thirty-first each year and shall include but shall
11 not be, including but not limited to the following subjects: election laws in general,
12 registration procedures, election procedures, election officials, voting machines,
13 tabulation and transmission of election returns, procedures used for casting and
14 counting absentee by mail and early voting ballots, and any other aspect of elections
15 the board deems appropriate. If the secretary of state intends to present
16 recommendations to the board to adopt as part of the board's report, the secretary of
17 state shall post its recommendations on the secretary of state's website at least
18 seventy-two hours prior to the meeting at which the recommendations are scheduled
19 to be presented. If additional recommendations from any source are submitted to the
20 staff of the board in advance of the meeting, those recommendations shall also be
21 posted on the secretary of state's website as soon as possible. The final report
22 adopted by the board shall be submitted to the House Committee on House and
23 Governmental Affairs and the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental
24 Affairs and posted on the secretary of state's website no later than January thirty-first
25 each year."
