Substitute for Original House Bill No. 304 by Representative Braud as proposed by the House Committee on Insurance

To repeal R.S. 22:1931.13, relative to the Sledge Jeansonne Louisiana Insurance Fraud Prevention Act; to repeal the termination provision of the Act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 22:1931.13 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

**Abstract:** Repeals the termination date of the Sledge Jeansonne La. Insurance Fraud Prevention Act.

Present law provides for the Sledge Jeansonne La. Insurance Fraud Prevention Act. Generally authorizes the attorney general to pursue a civil action against anyone who commits fraud or any other illegal practice to obtain insurance payments.

Present law terminates the Sledge Jeansonne La. Insurance Fraud Prevention Act on July 1, 2024.

Proposed law repeals the Act's termination provision and termination date. Otherwise retains present law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
