1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Thomas Alan
3 "Tom" Greene.

4 WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the House of
5 Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana has learned of the passing, on March 22,
6 2024, of former state senator Thomas Alan "Tom" Greene; and

7 WHEREAS, Tom was born to George and Wylie Mae Greene and was an incredibly
8 gifted student; he attended Louisiana State University where he earned a bachelor's degree
9 in electrical engineering, a master's degree in nuclear engineering, and a doctorate of
10 veterinary medicine; and

11 WHEREAS, Tom operated a veterinary practice in Livonia, Louisiana, for forty-four
12 years; he also served honorably as a distinguished member of the Louisiana Senate,
13 representing District No. 17, from 1992 until 2000; and

14 WHEREAS, Thomas Alan "Tom" Greene leaves to cherish his beautiful memory his
15 wife of fifty-one years, Cathy Greene; his children, Holland (Breux), Craig (Kristen), Jason
16 (Leigh), Ryan (Bonnie), and Boyd (Meagan); twenty-one grandchildren; and siblings,
17 Kenny, Donny, Craig, Mark, Kathy, Stephanie, and Tami; he will be deeply missed but
18 certainly never forgotten.
