A RESOLUTION

To commend the Geaux Far Louisiana Coalition and to designate April 2, 2024, as Geaux Far Day at the state capitol.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate April 2, 2024, as Geaux Far Day at the state capitol; does hereby commend the Geaux Far Louisiana Coalition for its support of Louisiana's children; and does hereby extend sincerest wishes that the coalition continue to prosper in its endeavors to improve early childhood care in the state.
