DISTRICTS/COMMUNICATIONS: Provides for an increase in wireless service charges for 911 services provided by the Terrebonne Parish Communications District

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:9109(C)(2), relative to charges for 911 emergency services;
3 to authorize the Terrebonne Parish Communications District to increase its service
4 charge on wireless phone service; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:9109(C)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

10 §9109. Additional service charge on wireless telecommunications service

11 * * *

12 C. Service charge. The governing authority of any district may levy a
13 CMRS emergency telephone service charge subject to and in accordance with the
14 provisions of this Subsection. Such service charge:

16 (2)(a) Shall not exceed one dollar and twenty-five cents per month per
17 wireless CMRS connection or the rate which the district levies or is authorized to
18 levy on CMRS users on August 1, 2016, whichever is higher.
