On page 1, line 3, after "through" delete "(27)" and insert "(26) and 1656.1"

AMENDMENT NO. 2On page 1, line 5, after the semicolon ";" and before "to" insert "to provide for the creation
of an advisory board to designate members and establish powers,"AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, line 8, after "through" delete "(27)" and insert "(26) and 1656.1"

AMENDMENT NO. 4On page 1, at the end of line 13, after "its" insert "governing authority" and delete "city
council"AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 1, delete line 17 in its entirety, and insert the following:

"(a) One member shall be appointed from House District 102 by the state
representative representing the district. a list of four names submitted by the
senators from that parish's legislative delegation, and

(b) One member shall be appointed from Senate District 7 by the state senator
representing the district. a list of six names submitted by the representatives of that
parish's legislative delegation."

On page 3, after line 3, insert the following:

"§1656.1. The Regional Transit Authority Advisory Board; creation; composition;
powers

1 A. The Regional Transit Authority Advisory Board, hereinafter referred to
2 as the "advisory board", is hereby created to assist the Regional Transit Authority
3 and shall have the purpose, composition, duties, and functions provided in this
4 Section.

5 B.(1) The purpose of the advisory board is to advise and make
6 recommendations to the Regional Transit Authority in making informed decisions
7 regarding the functions outlines in R.S. 48:1654(B).

8 (2) The advisory board shall not have the power to vote on any matters to be
9 decided by the board of commissioners.

10 (3) The advisory board shall be required to meet quarterly with the board of
11 commissioners.

12 C. The advisory board shall be composed of nine persons as follows:

13 (1) An employee of the Regional Transit Authority appointed by the chief
14 executive officer.

15 (2) A member of the Amalgamated Transit Union appointed by
16 Amalgamated Transit Union President/ Business agent.

17 (3) A member from the Downtown Development District appointed by the
18 executive director.

19 (4) Each president of the following universities: Loyola University, Tulane
20 University, Xavier University, Dillard University, Southern University at New
21 Orleans, and the University of Holy Cross."
