Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 368

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 13, after "benefit;" and before "to repeal" insert "to provide with respect to
3 the confidentiality of certain information;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, line 10, after "**firm**" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 11 and insert
6 the following:

7 **"or a Louisiana-based university department or academic faculty with**
8 **experience analyzing health insurance premiums. The department shall**
9 **ensure that the contractors are independent and free from conflicts of**
10 **interest that might affect the neutrality of the actuarial reviews. The**
11 **contractors, under the"**

12 AMENDMENT NO. 3

13 On page 3, line 15, after "costs" insert the following:

14 **", including an evaluation of whether the legislative proposal includes a**
15 **mandate requiring defrayal under such laws. The department may seek**
16 **the evaluation prior to requesting the remaining actuarial review**
17 **required by this Section."**

18 AMENDMENT NO. 4

19 On page 4, line 20, after "**insurance**" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 21 and
20 insert "**until the**"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 5

22 On page 5, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:

23 **"J. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to delegate or**
24 **require delegation of any federal or state authority to a non-state entity,**
25 **including but not limited to the authority to request fiscal impact**
26 **analyses from the Legislative Fiscal Office or the authority to make**
27 **determinations regarding the legal status of state benefit mandates**
28 **under state and federal law."**

29 AMENDMENT NO. 6

30 On page 5, at the beginning of line 15, change "**J.**" to "**K.**"

31 AMENDMENT NO. 7

32 On page 5, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:

33 **"L. Any claims, reimbursement, and other data, cost estimates,**
34 **and other information provided by a health insurer, health plan, or**
35 **other health insurance issuer to a contractor, the department, or any**
36 **other entity pursuant to the provisions of this Section shall be treated as**
37 **confidential."**
