Amendments proposed by Senator Morris to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 181 by Senator Morris

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- On page 1, line 2 after "Section 2(B) and" and before "of" change "Section 3" to "Section
 3 (B) and (C)"
- 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 5 On page 1, line 10 after "Section 2(B) and" and before "of" change "Section 3" to "Section 6 3(B) and (C)"
- 7 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 8 On page 2, delete lines 24 and 25 and insert:

9 "Additional positions may be added to the unclassified service and those
 10 positions may be revoked by rules adopted by a commission, or positions may
 11 otherwise be removed from the classified service as provided by law."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 2, delete lines 27 through 29, delete page 3, and on page 4, delete lines 1 through5 and insert:

15 "Section 3.(A) (B)(1) Appointment. The members shall be appointed by the governor, with 16 17 consent of the Senate, as hereinafter provided, for overlapping terms of six four 18 years. 19 (2) No person who has served shall serve as a member of the commission for more than two and one-half full terms in three consecutive terms shall be appointed 20 21 to the commission for the succeeding term. This Subparagraph shall not apply to any 22 person appointed to the commission prior to the effective date of this Subparagraph, 23 except that it shall apply to any term of service of any such person that begins after such date. 24 25 (C)(1) Nominations. The presidents of Centenary College at Shreveport, 26 Dillard University at New Orleans, Louisiana College at Pineville, Loyola University 27 at New Orleans, Tulane University of Louisiana at New Orleans, and Xavier University at New Orleans, after giving consideration to representation of all groups, 28 each shall separately nominate up to three persons for the purpose of filling 29 30 certain vacancies. The governor shall appoint one member three members of the 31 commission from the three persons nominated by each president the presidents. One 32 member of the commission shall be elected by the classified employees of the state 33 from their number as provided by law. A vacancy for any cause shall be filled by 34 appointment or election in accordance with the procedure or law governing the 35 appointment or election, and from the same source. Within thirty days after a 36 vacancy of a member appointed from the list of nominees submitted by the 37 presidents occurs, the president concerned presidents shall submit the required nominations. Within thirty days thereafter, the governor shall make his appointment, 38 39 with consent of the Senate. If the governor fails to appoint within thirty days, the 40 nominee whose name is first on the list of nominees automatically shall become a 41 member of the commission, with consent of the Senate. If any nominating authority 42 fails to submit nominees in the time required, or if one of the named institutions 43 ceases to exist, the governor shall make the appointment to the commission, with 44 consent of the Senate.

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1	(2) Beginning January 1, 2025, the governor is authorized to assign
2	staggered terms to the existing members of the commission by designating
3	which member shall serve a term of one year, two years, three years, or four
4	years. Any member who has served more than two four-year terms shall no
5	longer be eligible to serve and shall be replaced pursuant to the provisions of
6	this Section."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 5

8	On page 4, delete lines 13 through 19 and insert:
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9 "Do you support an amendment to provide for term limits for state civil 10 service commissioners, shorten their terms to four years, reduce the number of 11 nominations by private university presidents, provide for the appointment of officers, provide for transitional provisions, and authorize by law a reduction of the number 12 13 of required classified positions? 14
