A RESOLUTION

To designate Saturday, April 20, 2024, as Beausoleil Festival and Jambalaya Cook-Off Day in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the City of Broussard prides itself on its vibrant community spirit and its rich tapestry of cultural traditions; and

WHEREAS, jambalaya is an iconic Cajun food that is enjoyed across cultures and generations in Acadiana, embodying the spirit of family and community and the joy of sharing; and

WHEREAS, Joseph "Beausoleil" Broussard was the leader of the Acadian resistance during the French and Indian War in the mid-1700's, fought against British forces, was imprisoned, was expelled from his home in Nova Scotia, sailed thousands of miles from Canada, eventually settled in Louisiana in 1765, and remains a symbol of courage and fighting spirit of the Acadian people and their descendants: and

WHEREAS, the Beausoleil Festival and Jambalaya Cook-Off, which is held on the third Saturday in April, is a testament to the city's dedication to preserving the culture and history and bringing people together through the universal language of delicious food; and

WHEREAS, this festival not only showcases the extraordinary talents of local cook but also offers an opportunity for residents and visitors alike to partake in a day filled with delicious spices and tastes; and

WHEREAS, the Beausoleil Festival and Jambalaya Cook-Off aligns the city of Broussard and the state of Louisiana in their shared commitment to community engagement, economic development, and the promotion of cultural tourism.
