DISTRICTS/SPECIAL: Provides relative to compensation of commissioners of ambulance service districts in Allen Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:1261.2(D), relative to ambulance service districts in Allen Parish; to  
3 provide relative to the boards of commissioners of such districts; to provide for  
4 compensation of commissioners; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published  
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of  
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:1261.2(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §1261.2. Board of commissioners; membership; qualifications; appointment; terms,  
11 vacancies; removal; officers; meetings

13 D. Commissioners may receive a per diem, in an amount not to exceed one  
14 hundred dollars, for each day of their attendance at meetings of the board, up to  
15 twenty-four meeting days per year. The per diem shall be paid out of district funds.

**Abstract:** Authorizes members of the boards of commissioners of ambulance service districts in Allen Parish to receive a per diem for their attendance at meetings of the board.

Present law (R.S. 33:1261.2) provides that ambulance service districts in Allen Parish are governed by a board of commissioners appointed by the Allen Parish Police Jury. Further provides for the qualifications, appointments, terms, and meetings of such boards.

Proposed law retains present law and authorizes commissioners to receives a per diem of not more than \$100 for each day of their attendance at meetings of the board. Further provides that commissioners may receive the per diem for not more than 24 meetings per year.
