**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 762  
by Representative BamburgAMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, "To" delete the remainder of the line and insert "To amend and reenact R.S. 17:183.3(B)(3) and to enact R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(g), relative to student"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, line 3, after "assessments;" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 4 and 5 and insert "to authorize public school governing authorities to select alternate assessments to be administered pursuant to the Louisiana Educational Assessment Program; to subject such assessments to the approval of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education; to require the state board to adopt rules relative to such alternate assessments; to provide for implementation; to prohibit scores on certain assessments administered to certain students from being used for purposes of the school and district accountability system;"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, line 8, after "Section 1." and before "is" delete "R.S. 17:24.4(F)(5)" and insert "R.S. 17:183.3(B)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(g)"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 1, at the end of line 11, delete "waivers; prohibited" and delete line 12 and insert "waivers"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 1, line 14, change "F." to "F.(1)"

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 1, delete lines 16 and 17 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert the following:

"(g)(i) Each public school governing authority may administer national norm-referenced assessments approved by the state board to students in grades three through eleven in lieu of the assessments required by Subparagraph (f) of this Paragraph. This authority includes but is not limited to the authority to use the ACT in lieu of end-of-course assessments, in which case a student shall be required to attain a minimum score as determined by the board on both the English and mathematics sections in order to be eligible to graduate from high school.

(ii) The state board shall adopt rules to provide for the implementation of Item (i) of this Subparagraph, which shall provide for, at a minimum, the following:

(aa) The board's approval of alternate assessments.

(bb) The measurement of growth in student achievement as measured by alternate assessments for purposes of the school and district accountability system and the evaluation of teachers and administrators.

(cc) The level of proficiency on alternate assessments required for student promotion.
