 Provides relative to mandatory judicial training

Proposed law mandates that, beginning 1/01/25, all supreme court justices, courts of appeal judges, district court judges, parish court judges, and city court judges, attend an annual specialized trauma-informed eight hour course developed and implemented by the supreme court; requires the supreme court to establish a committee including, but not limited to, designees from the Louisiana Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Tulane School of Law Domestic Violence Clinic; Children's Hospital of New Orleans, and the Louisiana Bar Association; provides for topics covered during the eight hour course; requires the Law Library of Louisiana to maintain a current online and printed database of training materials prepared in compliance with the proposed law.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures to the Supreme Court and Local Funds expenditures in courts of appeal, district courts, parish courts, and city courts associated with possible lodging, mileage, and per diem costs to facilitate and attend trauma-informed training in-person. District courts would incur Local Funds expenditures paid by their respective judicial expense funds (with requests for reimbursement from the Supreme Court) for district court judges attending the training, and parish and city court judges would incur non-reimbursable Local Funds expenditures.


The proposed law is silent as to the method of delivery of the training contemplated, which if offered virtually, would eliminate the expenditures related to lodging, mileage, and per diems. The exact fiscal impact to the Supreme Court, courts of appeal, district courts, parish courts, and city courts is indeterminable, as it is unknown the method of delivery or location of the training contemplated within the proposed law.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
