1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 1, line 2, after "ordinances;" delete "to", delete line 3 in its entirety, and on line 4,  
3 delete "for integrated coastal projects in the state's local master plan;"4 AMENDMENT NO. 25 On page 1, line 5, after "application;" and before "and" insert "to provide relative to the  
6 enforcement of local ordinance provisions; to provide for an effective date;"7 AMENDMENT NO. 38 On page 1, at the beginning of line 9, insert "A."9 AMENDMENT NO. 410 On page 1, at the end of line 10, after "highways" delete "and" and on line 11, delete  
11 "integrated coastal protection projects included in the state's local master plan"12 AMENDMENT NO. 513 On page 1, line 12, after "all" and before "ordinances" insert "substantive"14 AMENDMENT NO. 6

15 On page 1, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following:

16 "B.(1) Notwithstanding any provision contained in this Section to the  
17 contrary, any violation of a local ordinance shall be timely raised, and any  
18 enforcement proceedings shall be commenced prior to the issuance of any applicable  
19 federal and state permits.20 (2) The failure to comply with Paragraph (B)(1) of this Section shall relieve  
21 the state and any state agency of further responsibility under this Section."22 AMENDMENT NO. 7

23 On page 1, after line 19, insert the following:

24 "Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor  
25 or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law  
26 without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the  
27 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by  
28 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
