COMMENDATIONS: Commends Louisiana State University at Shreveport on its high state and national rankings in the second annual Economic Mobility Index

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To commend Louisiana State University at Shreveport on its high state and national
3	rankings in the second annual Economic Mobility Index.
4	WHEREAS, LSU at Shreveport was ranked the highest in the state of Louisiana and
5	among the nation's best in the second annual Economic Mobility Index, which measures how
6	effectively institutions help low-income students improve their socioeconomic level; and
7	WHEREAS, LSU Shreveport earned Tier 1 status, meaning that it ranked in the top
8	20% of the more than 1,300 colleges and universities evaluated; and
9	WHEREAS, the report was released by the organization Third Way, a national think
10	tank that believes higher education is critical to securing a middle-class lifestyle; and
11	WHEREAS, the study used data from the most recent College Scorecard, which
12	reflects institution-level data from the 2020-21 academic year, and the U.S. Census Bureau's
13	American Community Survey; and
14	WHEREAS, the report measured the percentage of a school's student body that is
15	low-income and how long it takes those low-income students to pay off the cost of their
16	degree; this data is used to construct a school's Economic Mobility Index; and
17	WHEREAS, nearly 37% of LSU at Shreveport's student population receives federal
18	Pell grants; and
19	WHEREAS, based on the amount that low-income students pay out of pocket for
20	their education after scholarships and grants, the report calculated that low-income students
21	pay off their LSUS degrees in only 2.77 years; and

1	WHEREAS, LSU Shreveport has created entities such as the Student Success Center
2	and other services such as peer mentoring, supplemental instruction and tutoring, counseling
3	and career services, and various co-curricular activities that have impacted retention and
4	graduation rates.
5	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
6	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Louisiana State University at Shreveport on
7	its high state and national rankings in the second annual Economic Mobility Index and does
8	hereby extend sincerest wishes that the university and its students continue their excellent
9	work and always strive for greatness.
