Present law prohibits medication from being administered to any student at school without parental authorization and an order from a physician or dentist licensed in La. or an adjacent state. Further prohibits the performance of noncomplex health procedures unless prescribed by a physician licensed in La. or an adjacent state.

Proposed law allows the administration of medication and performance of noncomplex health procedures if prescribed by such persons licensed in any state in the U.S.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 17:436(B)(3)(a) and 436.1(B)(1)(a))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the engrossed bill:

1. Apply expansion of a physician's licensure location to prescriptions written for the performance of noncomplex health procedures at school.
