3 long-standing record.

4 WHEREAS, the Parkway High School boys' 4x400 meter relay team won gold at the
5 District 1-5A championship meet with a time of 3:20.14; the relay team broke the previous
6 school record of 3:22.10 which was set in 1988; and

7 WHEREAS, the Parkway boys' 4x400 meter relay team is composed of Brody
8 Hocter, Brennan Robin, Gabriel Falting, and Will Achee; these boys have gone undefeated
9 in competition this year; and

10 WHEREAS, Parkway also claimed gold in the boys' 4x400 meter relay at the
11 regional championship competition and secured a spot to compete at the Louisiana High
12 School Athletic Association Outdoor Track & Field state meet on May 4; and

13 WHEREAS, in addition to the record-setting performance, Parkway claimed its first-
14 ever regional championship; and

15 WHEREAS, the Parkway High School boys' 4x400 meter relay team and the entire
16 Parkway track and field team are most deserving of the highest recognition for their
17 incredible achievements.

18 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
19 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Parkway High School boys' 4x400 meter
20 relay team for breaking a long-standing record and does hereby extend sincerest wishes that
