

SENATE BILL NO. 204

1 AN ACT

2 To provide relative to state highways; to designate a portion of Louisiana Highway 1064 in
3 Tangipahoa Parish as the "Rev. Alfred L. Hart Memorial Highway"; to provide for
4 restrictions on costs of materials to the department; and to provide for related
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 **Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a portion**
8 **of Louisiana Highway 1064 in Tangipahoa Parish, beginning at the intersection of**
9 **Louisiana Highway 1064 and Interstate I-55 and ending at North Cherry Street**
10 **Extension Road, is hereby designated as "Rev. Alfred L. Hart Memorial Highway".**

11 **Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby**
12 **directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided local or**
13 **private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs**
14 **for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed**
15 **the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.**
