Amendments proposed by Legislative Bureau to Reengrossed House Bill No. 384 by Representative Knox

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 8, following "violation." insert:

3 "In addition, notice shall be transmitted to the insured through any digitized
4 credentials established pursuant to R.S. 39:17.2(D) within one to five days before
5 issuing the violation. The reinstatement fees for violations of Paragraph (2) of this
6 Subsection shall be as follows: two hundred fifty dollars for a first violation, five
7 hundred dollars for a second violation, and one thousand dollars for a third or
8 subsequent violation. The reinstatement fee shall not be owed for an alleged
9 violation of Paragraph (2) of this Subsection when proof of the required security is
10 provided to the secretary within sixty days of the date of the notice. If at the time of
11 reinstatement, a person has multiple violations and is within sixty days of the notice,
12 the total amount of fees to be paid shall not exceed eight hundred fifty dollars for
13 violations of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection and one thousand seventy-five dollars
14 for violations of Paragraph (2) of this Subsection. At no time shall the total amount
15 of fees, including administrative fees, exceed two hundred fifty dollars for persons
16 sixty-five years or older. After sixty days of the date of the notice, all fees shall be
17 considered final delinquent debt and therefore owed, and the eight-hundred-fifty-
18 dollar limit for persons under sixty-five years shall no longer apply."
