SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates May 9 annually as Louisiana Gray Day to increase awareness of brain cancer

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To designate May 9 annually as Louisiana Gray Day to increase awareness of brain cancer.
3	WHEREAS, an estimated one million Americans are living with a primary brain
4	tumor; there are no known ways to prevent brain and central nervous system cancers; and
5	WHEREAS, brain cancer is one of the most incurable forms of cancer; brain cancer
6	strikes men, women, and children of any race and any age and is the leading cause of
7	cancer-related death in children under twenty; and
8	WHEREAS, data reported in 2023 indicates that approximately 59% of all brain
9	tumors occur in females, 41% of all brain tumors occur in males, and 3.9% of all brain
10	tumors cases diagnosed occur in children ages 0-14 years; and
11	WHEREAS, brain tumors are the leading cause of childhood cancer-related death
12	among children ages 0-14, and the second leading cause of cancer-related death in children
13	under age twenty; and
14	WHEREAS, brain cancer can have more life-altering psychological, cognitive,
15	behavioral, and physical effects than other cancers; there are about 230 cancer deaths per
16	year among persons in Louisiana; and
17	WHEREAS, the month of May is recognized nationally as brain cancer awareness
18	month; Louisiana recognizes May 9 each year as Louisiana Gray Day to help bring greater
19	awareness to this cancer and perhaps prevent some brain cancer-related deaths; and
20	WHEREAS, Louisiana is the only state with an annual day for brain cancer
21	awareness.
