#### HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 202

#### A RESOLUTION

To commend the students and faculty of the Lafayette Parish School System for placing first overall in the Louisiana Governor's Games 27th Annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Governor's Games are the state's premier amateur sporting event; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Parish School System finished first overall in the 27th annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet; and

WHEREAS, to place first, Lafayette scored 2,378 points, compared to second-place defending champs St. Tammany, with 2,307 points, and third-place Rapides, with 2,273 points; and

WHEREAS, the elementary fitness meet competition involves seven fitness-related events: the 50-yard dash, the shuttle run, pull-ups, the standing long-jump, curl-ups or sit-ups, the 600-yard run, and the V-sit and reach; and

WHEREAS, the top-two boys and girls from each parish go to Alexandria/Pineville annually to compete for the fitness title; and

WHEREAS, top performer, Kolbron Johnlouis, led the way with 639 individual points; and

WHEREAS, teammates Kohen Breaux, Liberty Arnaud, and Ameila Bodin anchored their parish to victory; and

WHEREAS, since 1997, the elementary fitness meet has served as the Olympic Games for elementary school-aged children in 30 parishes across the state, with more than 200,000 competing for the state fitness crown.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the students and faculty of the Lafayette Parish School System for placing first overall in the Louisiana Governor's Games 27th Annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet and does hereby extend sincerest wishes that they continue their excellent work and always strive for greatness.
