2 On page 1, line 7, delete "amended"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete lines 18 and 19 in their entirety

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 in their entirety

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 2, at the beginning of line 3, change "(8)" to "(6)" and on line 4, change "(7)" to  
9 "(5)"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 3, line 4, after "writing" insert "and contain an email address for correspondence"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 3, line 13, after "later than" change "five" to "ten"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page 3, line 18, after "within" change "seventy-two hours after" to "fifteen days after  
16 acknowledgment of"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 8

18 On page 3, line 26, after "action for" insert "mandamus due to" and after "entity" insert a  
19 period ":", and delete the remainder of the line

20 AMENDMENT NO. 9

21 On page 3, between lines 26 and 27 insert the following:

22 "J. A protected individual or the judicial administrator's office may bring an  
23 action for a violation of this Section against a third party for:"

24 AMENDMENT NO. 10

25 On page 4, at the beginning of line 7, change "J." to "K."

26 AMENDMENT NO. 11

27 On page 4, at the beginning of line 15, change "K." to "L."

1 AMENDMENT NO. 12

2 On page 4, at the end of line 17, insert the following:

3 "This provision nor any other penalty provision shall apply to a governmental  
4 entity as defined in Subsection D of this Section. Immunity also applies to any  
5 person employed by the governmental entity who is performing services in his  
6 capacity as an employee of the governmental entity."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 13

8 On page 4, after line 17, insert "Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall become effective  
9 on February 1, 2025."
