SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH. Designates May 8, 2024, as Pickleball Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

A RESOLUTION

2	To designate May 8, 2024, as Pickleball Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.
3	WHEREAS, in 1965, Joel Pritchard, a congressman representing the state of
4	Washington, and a friend Bill Bell, played the first pickleball match on an old badminton
5	court with ping-pong paddles and a perforated plastic ball; and
6	WHEREAS, the following weekend, they introduced another friend, Barney
7	McCallum, to the game they invented and together the three men created rules, relying
8	heavily on badminton, keeping in mind the original purpose, which was to provide a fun
9	game that the whole family could play together; and
10	WHEREAS, in 1972, a corporation was formed to protect the creation of this new
11	sport; and
12	WHEREAS, in 1984, the United States Amateur Pickleball Association (USAPA)
13	was organized to perpetuate the growth and advancement of pickleball on a national level,
14	with the first rulebook being published in March of that year; and
15	WHEREAS, after years of steady increase in participation, pickleball has seen a rise
16	in popularity in recent years because of its easy learning curve and use of pre-existing tennis
17	infrastructure; and
18	WHEREAS, the estimated number of pickleball players has increased to thirteen

1	million six hundred thousand in the United States as of 2023, according to a 2024 Sports &
2	Fitness Industry Association report; and
3	WHEREAS, Louisiana, particularly the Lafayette region, is part of the pickleball
4	craze sweeping the country; and
5	WHEREAS, in September, 2023, plans were unveiled for a one hundred twenty
6	thousand square-foot indoor sports complex to be built by Lafayette Consolidated
7	Government at the site of Beaullieu Park and Comeaux Recreation Center, the only facility
8	of its kind between Jacksonville, Florida, and Houston, Texas, along the Interstate 10
9	corridor; and
10	WHEREAS, the sports complex will have about three times the floor space of the
11	Cajundome, offering eight basketball courts and sixteen volleyball courts, with the versatility
12	to accommodate other indoor sports like pickleball and wrestling; and
13	WHEREAS, other Lafayette-area parks have joined the pickleball sensation by
14	adding courts, including the Thomas Park Recreational Center, the George Dupuis
15	Recreational Center, and Youngsville Sports Complex, among others; and
16	WHEREAS, the growth of pickleball's popularity has encouraged entrepreneurs from
17	Lafayette, like Bruce Smith and his company, Battle Cry Sports, to design, market, and sell
18	a line of specialized pickleball paddles for competitive and skilled play; and
19	WHEREAS, Lafayette locals Jenny Thibodeaux, Jacques Poirrier, Paul Azar III,
20	Benjamin Roth, and Stephen Roma were inspired to establish the Lafayette Pickleball Club,
21	which recently opened a facility with six indoor climate-controlled courts and a membership
22	list growing every day; and
23	WHEREAS, Louisiana has truly embraced the founders' original purpose of
24	pickleball to provide a fun game that the whole family can participate in and enjoy.
25	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
26	does hereby designate May 8, 2024, as Pickleball Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.
27	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to Bruce
28	Smith, Jenny Thibodeaux, Jacques Poirrier, Paul Azar III, Benjamin Roth, and Stephen
29	Roma.
