AN ACT To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2063 and 2076, relative to the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System; to provide for retirement allowances; to provide for application of leave in calculating retirement allowances; to provide for optional allowances; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters. Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published. Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 11:2063 and 2076 are hereby amended and reenacted to read as

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§2063. Service on which retirement allowances are based

Creditable service at retirement on which the retirement allowance of a 11 member shall be based shall consist of the membership service rendered by him 12 13 since he last became a member, and also, if he has a prior service certificate which 14 is in full force and effect, the amount of service certified on his prior service 15 certificate, and shall include any. Any unused sick leave and any unused annual 16 leave at the date of retirement shall be used in the calculation of the retirement 17 allowance; however, for any person whose system membership first begins on 18 or after July 1, 2024, unused leave shall not be used for purposes of attaining 19 eligibility.

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- 21 §2076. Optional allowances

With the provision that no optional selection shall be effective in case a beneficiary dies within thirty days after retirement, and that such a beneficiary shall be considered as an active member at the time of death; until the first payment on account of any benefit becomes normally due, any member may elect to receive his benefit in a retirement allowance payable throughout life, or he may elect to receive the actuarial equivalent at that time, of his retirement allowance in a reduced

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| 2 | Option 1. If he dies before he has received in annuity payments the present |
| 3 | value of his annuity as it was at the time of his retirement, the balance shall be paid |

| 16 | Option 4. Some other benefit or benefits shall be paid either to the member |
| 17 | or to such person or persons as he shall nominate provided, such other benefit or |
| 18 | benefits, together with the reduced retirement allowance, shall be certified by the |
| 19 | actuary to be of equivalent actuarial value to his retirement allowance, and approved |
| 20 | by the board of trustees. |
| 21 | Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not |
| 22 | signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature |
| 23 | by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If |
| 24 | vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become |
| 25 | effective on the day following such approval. |
