1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "Procedure" and before the comma "," change "Art. 926.1(A)(1) and
3 (H)(3)" to "Art. 926.1(A)(1), (H)(3), and (K)"

5 On page 1, line 5, after "circumstances;" and before "and" insert "to provide relative to the
6 DNA Testing Post-Conviction Relief for Indigents Fund;"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 7

17 On page 2, after line 9, add the following:

18 "K. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special fund designated as
19 the DNA Testing Post-Conviction Relief for Indigents Fund. The fund shall consist
20 of money specially appropriated by the legislature. No other public money may be
21 used to pay for the DNA testing authorized under the provisions of this Article. The
22 fund shall be administered by the ~~Louisiana Public Defender Board~~ office of the
23 state public defender. The fund shall be segregated from all other funds and shall
24 be used exclusively for the purposes established under the provisions of this Article.
25 If the court finds that a petitioner under this Article is indigent, the fund shall pay for
26 the testing as authorized in the court order."
