Subject: Saltwater Fishing Licenses

WILDLIFE & FISHERIES

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Provides relative to saltwater and charter fishing licenses and fees

Proposed law will change the Charter Boat Fishing Fund into the Charter Boat Fishing Escrow Account. Proposed law separates and itemizes the charter promotion fee from the charter fishing license fee. Present law includes a \$20 fee per license for three (3) day saltwater tours and a \$10 fee per license for three (3) day freshwater tours. For each license sold \$7.50 is collected and deposited into the Charter Boat Fishing Escrow Account. Proposed law would separate the \$7.50 charter promotion fee from the total license fee to be charged separately. Proposed law will set the fee for a 3-day saltwater fishing charter license at \$12.50 with an additional \$7.50 charter promotion fee, and for a 3-day freshwater fishing charter license at \$2.50 with an additional \$7.50 charter promotion fee. The overall cost of a license will not change as it will remain a total cost of \$20 and \$10 respectively. Costs for licenses are the same for residents and nonresidents.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Expenditures once made to the LA Charter Boat Association (LCBA) from the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF) operating budget will no longer be necessary as the proposed change to an escrow account would allow funds to be utilized by the LCBA without an appropriation to LDWF. Additionally, the proposed legislation will clarify the components of the fee for charter fishing licenses.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation separates and itemizes the \$7.50 charter promotion fee from the \$12.50 saltwater and \$2.50 freshwater charter fishing license fee. These revenues collected by the LDWF previously deposited as statutory dedications into the Charter Boat Fishing Fund will now be deposited into the Charter Boat Escrow Account for direct utilization by the LA Charter Boat Association.
