## SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Provides an insurer has certain restrictions for using aerial images for cancelling or nonrenewing a homeowner's insurance policy unless the image was taken within 24 months of the date of cancellation or nonrenewal of the policy.
- 2. Provides an insurer may use all images of an immovable property without a time limitation for identification, location or improvements of the immovable property.
- 3. Make technical changes.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides an insurer has certain restrictions for using aerial images for cancelling or nonrenewing a homeowner's insurance policy unless the image was taken within 24 months of the date of cancellation or nonrenewal of the policy. <u>Proposed law</u> provides an insurer may use all images of an immovable property without a time limitation for identification, location or improvements of the immovable property.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "aerial images" as pictures, recordings, or any physical evidence captured in the airspace above a property from an aircraft or other airborne platform, including but not limited to third-party proprietary aerial imagery taken by a fixed-wing aircraft and satellites.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
