

SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2024 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Education to Reengrossed House Bill No. 266 by Representative Amedee

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S." and before "relative" delete "5025(3)(c), (5), and (6)," and
3 insert "5025(5), (6), and (8) and to enact R.S. 17:5025(9),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "language;" delete the remainder of the line and on line 5, delete
6 "science courses to the elective science courses;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, after "R.S. 17:5025" delete the remainder of the line and insert "(5), (6),
9 and (8) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 17:5025(9) is hereby enacted to read"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 22 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 7

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 2, after line 29, insert the following:

14 "(8) Computer Science - one unit. This requirement shall be satisfied as provided
15 in Paragraph (2) or (3) of this Section.

16 (9) For the purposes of this Section, any core curriculum course that is taken by a
17 student who has been identified as gifted pursuant to State Board of Elementary and
18 Secondary Education policy and that is taken in fulfillment of the student's
19 Individualized Education Program shall be considered a gifted course and shall fulfill
20 the core curriculum requirement in its given subject area.

21 Section 2. (A) The provisions of R.S. 17:5025(8) and (9) as provided in Section 2
22 of this Act shall supersede and control if the Act that originated as House Bill No.
23 264 of this 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature becomes law, regardless of the
24 order of passage. If the Act that originated as House Bill No. 264 of this 2024
25 Regular Session of the Legislature does not become law, Section 2 of this Act shall
26 not become effective.

27 (B) Regarding any conflict between the provisions of this Act that amend and
28 reenact R.S. 17:5025(5) and the provisions that amend and reenact that Paragraph as
29 contained in the Act that originated as House Bill No. 264 of this 2024 Regular
30 Session of the Legislature, the provisions of this Act shall supersede and control
31 regardless of the order of passage."
