13	B. No city or parish school board shall require any employee other than a					
14	registered nurse, licensed medical physician, or an appropriate licensed health					
15	professional to perform noncomplex health procedures until all the following					
16	conditions have been met:

18	(3)(a) Following the training provided for in Paragraph (2) of this					
19	Subsection, no noncomplex health procedure, except screenings and activities of					
20	daily living such as toileting/diapering, toilet training, oral/dental hygiene, oral					
21	feeding, lifting, and positioning may be performed unless prescribed in writing by					
22	a physician licensed to practice medicine in the state of Louisiana or <del>an adjacent</del> <u>any</u>
