Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law (C.Cr.P. Art. 311) defines "electronic bonds".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that an electronic bond may be executed and the sheriff may approve agents to execute the bond.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a licensed bail bond producer applying for electronic bond authority may make an application to the sheriff and shall be domiciled and maintain a principal place of business in this state and possess a La. bail bond producer license for at least three years preceding the date of application.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the approving sheriff authority may require any documents deemed necessary to verify the information contained in the application.
