Amendments proposed by Senator Miguez to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 502 by Senator Miguez

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete the set of Senate Floor Amendments, proposed by Senator Miguez and adopted by
3 the Senate on April 24, 2024, designated as SFASB502 CLAPINSKID 2561.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 2 through 4 and insert:

6 "To amend and reenact R.S. 44:5(B)(4), relative to public records; to prohibit access
7 to records in the office of the governor pertaining to the security of the governor or
8 his family; to provide for sufficient information; and to provide for related matters."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, line 6, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 7 through
11 17, and delete page 2, and insert:

12 "R.S. 44:5(B)(4) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

13 §5. Records of the office of the governor

14 * * *

15 B.(1) * * *

16 (4) Notwithstanding Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Subsection, any record of
17 the office of the governor pertaining to the schedule of the governor, his spouse, or
18 his child that contains security details that if made public may impair the safety of
19 the governor, his spouse, or his child may be held confidential ~~for a period not to~~
20 ~~exceed seven days following the scheduled event.~~ However, nothing in this
21 Paragraph shall be interpreted or construed in a manner to make confidential all
22 records concerning a meeting or event that the governor attends and transportation
23 related thereto. The governor may keep a record concerning a meeting or event that
24 the governor attends and transportation thereto privileged for a period not to exceed
25 seven days after the occurrence of the meeting or event.
