1. Adds an effective date for proposed law of when a specific appropriation for the implementation of proposed law by the legislature is effective.

Present law requires that every sworn, commissioned law enforcement officer employed on a full-time basis by a bona fide police agency of the state or its political subdivisions, other than the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries, and headquartered in the city of New Orleans, who serves the welfare of the public in the capacity of a police officer by providing police services while patrolling levees, waterways, and riverfront areas, or while patrolling bridges that are within the boundaries of the city of New Orleans, be paid by the state extra compensation in the amount of \$600 per month in addition to the compensation now paid to him by his employer.

Proposed law retains present law and adds law enforcement agencies headquartered in the city of Lake Charles that patrol levees, waterways, and riverfront areas, or patrol bridges to the list of eligible agencies to receive monthly supplemental pay of \$600.

Effective upon a specific appropriation for the implementation of proposed law by the legislature.
