

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

HB 737

Dickerson

CRIME/MISDEMEANOR: Prohibits a person from engaging in picketing at the residence or dwelling of an individual

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Specifies that no person shall petition, picket, demonstrate, or assemble with other persons within a minimum of 50 feet of, rather than near an individual's residence.
2. Removes proposed law language relative to the individual's right to enjoy his residence.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law provides that no person shall petition, picket, demonstrate, or assemble with other persons within 50 feet of an individual's residence in a manner which interferes, disrupts, threatens to disrupt, or harasses the individual's right to control or use his residence.

Proposed law provides that whoever violates proposed law shall be fined not more than \$500. Further provides that each day on which a violation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

Proposed law defines the term "residence".
