CRIME: Provides relative to marijuana paraphernalia

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Removes <u>proposed law</u> relative to persons with an occupational license.
- 3. Provides a range of fines for first, second, and subsequent convictions.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides penalties for violations of law regarding the possession, sale, and use of drug paraphernalia.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes incarceration as a punishment for the possession of certain drug paraphernalia in quantities not exceeding those required for individual personal use.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the punishment for the possession of certain drug paraphernalia in quantities not exceeding those required for individual personal use is a fine of:

- (1) \$100 on a first conviction.
- (2) \$500 on a second conviction.
- (3) \$2,500 on a third or subsequent conviction.
