EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable one-time increase in Local Fund expenditures for Registrars of Voters to provide assistance to voters registering to vote using the electronic voter registration application. The Department of State reports that not all Registrars of Voters have the equipment necessary to assist individuals who want to complete the electronic voter registration application process. Proposed law may result in one-time costs to purchase equipment, for example - a tablet, kiosk, or computer. Under current law, the parish governing authority is responsible for providing all necessary equipment for the registrar.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
