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AN ACT

To amend and reenact Section 2 of Act No. 386 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature, relative to prescription; to provide relative to the prescriptive period for certain civil actions against a person for certain acts committed against a minor; to provide relative to implementation; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 386 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

* * *

Section 2. Any person whose cause of action related to sexual abuse of a minor was barred by liberative prescription shall be permitted to file an action under R.S. 9:2800.9 on

1 or before June 14, ~~2024~~ 2027. It is the express intent of the legislature to revive until June
2 14, ~~2024~~ 2027, any cause of action related to sexual abuse of a minor that previously
3 prescribed under any Louisiana prescriptive period.
