LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS: Provides for the certification by the Council on Peace Officer Standards and Training of the New Orleans inspector general and his investigators

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Deletes provisions of <u>proposed law</u> designating the office of inspector general to the city of New Orleans as a law enforcement agency and conferring all investigating powers and privileges belonging to a law enforcement agency under state law as necessary in furtherance of the authority, duties, powers, and functions of <u>present law</u>.
- 2. Adds provision authorizing the inspector general and investigators employed in the New Orleans Office of Inspector General to carry a firearm provided they annually become P.O.S.T. certified and have proof of qualification, in addition to a valid identification as a retired law enforcement officer.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for investigative powers for any local ethics entity, ethics review board, or office of inspector general.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the inspector general and investigators employed in the New Orleans Office of Inspector General to carry a firearm provided they annually become P.O.S.T. certified and have proof of qualification, in addition to a valid identification as a retired law enforcement officer.
