A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend the Wossman High School boys and girls basketball teams on winning the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) 2024 Division II Non-Select State Championships.

WHEREAS, the Wossman High School boys and girls basketball teams won the LHSAA 2024 Division II Non-Select State Championships; and

WHEREAS, the Wossman girls team captured their third straight state championship title by defeating South Beauregard High School, 63-22, in the championship game held on March 2nd at the University Center in Hammond, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, senior Da'Naya Ross, Most Valuable Player, led three Lady Wildcats in double-figures with sixteen points, including four three-pointers; and

WHEREAS, guided by Head Coach Otis Robinson Jr., the team finished the season with a team record of 30 wins and only 4 losses; and

WHEREAS, the Wossman boys basketball team captured Wossman's fourth state title in school history with a 70-65 victory against top-seeded Iowa High School on March 8th at Burton Coliseum in Lake Charles, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the Wossman boys team had four players in double figures; senior Krystian Lewis, Most Outstanding Player, led the team with twenty-five points, eight rebounds, and four steals; and

WHEREAS, guided by Head Coach-Athletic Director Casey Jones, the Wossman boys basketball team completed the season with a team record of 34 wins and only 4 losses; and

WHEREAS, the Wossman boys and girls basketball teams, the coaches, and the training staff are most deserving of the highest recognition for the incredible achievements of both teams.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Wossman High School boys and girls basketball teams on winning the LHSAA 2024 Division II Non-Select State Championships.
