

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**HCR 35****2024 Regular Session****Wright**

LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT: Provides for a special joint committee to review the Administrative Procedure Act, the Louisiana Administrative Code, the public's involvement in proposed rulemaking, and comparisons of other states' regulatory environments

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Reduce the number of House members on the committee from four to three.
2. Add a member appointed by the governor to the committee.
3. Rather than have a member of House serve as chair and a member of the Senate serve as vice chair of the committee, provides that a member of House serves as chair during even-numbered years and a member of the Senate serves as chair during odd-numbered years.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Creates the Special Legislative Committee on Regulatory Reform, composed of three members of the House selected by the speaker, with one designated as the chairman in even-numbered years, and three members of the Senate selected by the president, with one designated as the chairman in odd-numbered years, and one member appointed by the governor to study and make recommendations with respect to Louisiana's regulatory environment and report findings to the legislature prior to Dec. 31, 2024.
