2	To amend and reenact R.S. 18:1308(B)(1), relative to the delivery of absentee by mail
3	ballots; to limit the number of marked ballots that a person may send to the registrar
4	through the United States Postal Service or commercial courier; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 18:1308(B)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1308. Absentee voting by mail
9	* * *
10	B.(1) The ballot shall be marked as provided in R.S. 18:1310 and returned
11	to the registrar by the United States Postal Service, a commercial courier, or hand
12	delivery. If delivered by other than the voter, a commercial courier, or the United
13	States Postal Service, the registrar shall require that the person making such delivery
14	sign a statement, prepared by the secretary of state, certifying that he has the
15	authorization and consent of the voter to hand deliver the marked ballot. For
16	purposes of this Subsection, "commercial courier" shall have the same meaning as
17	provided in R.S. 13:3204(D). No person except the immediate family of the voter,
18	as defined in this Code, shall hand deliver submit by any means or send for delivery
