2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:183.3(B)(3) and to enact R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(g), relative to
3	student assessments; to remove the requirement that students pursuing a career
4	diploma take the ACT; to authorize such students to take the Armed Services
5	Vocational Aptitude Battery; to authorize students pursuing a diploma other than a
6	career diploma to take the WorkKeys test and the Armed Services Vocational
7	Aptitude Battery under certain circumstances; to require the State Board of
8	Elementary and Secondary Education to develop a system of equivalent scores for
9	such tests for school and district accountability purposes; to provide for
10	implementation; and to provide for related matters.
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
12	Section 1. R.S. 17:183.3(B)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
13	17:24.4(F)(1)(g) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

15	required subjects; Louisiana Educational Assessment Program; parish or city
16	school board comprehensive pupil progression plans; waivers
