AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 33:9109(C)(2), relative to charges for 911 emergency services; to authorize the Terrebonne Parish Communications District to increase its service charge on wireless phone service; and to provide for related matters.

Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of Louisiana.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:9109(C)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
§9109. Additional service charge on wireless telecommunications service

* * *

C. Service charge. The governing authority of any district may levy a CMRS emergency telephone service charge subject to and in accordance with the provisions of this Subsection. Such service charge:

* * *

(2)(a) Shall not exceed one dollar and twenty-five cents per month per wireless CMRS connection or the rate which the district levies or is authorized to levy on CMRS users on August 1, 2016, whichever is higher.

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, the governing authority of the Terrebonne Parish Communications District may levy

1 a CMRS emergency telephone service charge of not more than one dollar and eighty-
2 five cents per month per wireless CMRS connection.
