16	person financially interested in any race track or race meeting licensed by the				
17	commission. Except as provided in Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph, no member

19	licensed by the commission.				
20	(b) Three members shall be owners Any member may be an owner of				
21	racehorses which that participate in any race meeting licensed by the commission.

C. Members shall serve without salary, but shall receive a per diem at the rate of fifty one hundred dollars per day while attending official meetings, regular or special, of the commission called by the chairman, or in his absence, one of the vice chairmen, not to exceed two four thousand dollars per annum. The commission shall reimburse its members and employees for all travel expenses and disbursements incurred by them in the discharge of their official duties. They shall give a bond to the governor in the amount of ten thousand dollars, conditioned that they will faithfully and honestly perform the duties of their office. The premium for the bond shall be paid by the commission.
