### 1 AN ACT 2 To enact R.S. 42:1123(36), to allow a public servant and related persons to advertise with 3 a governmental entity subject to certain conditions; to provide for effectiveness; and 4 to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 42:1123(36) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §1123. Exceptions 8 This Part shall not preclude: \* \* 9 \* 10 (36) A public servant, an immediate family member of a public servant, or 11 a legal entity in which the public servant or a member of his immediate family has 12 a substantial economic interest from providing to an agency of the governmental 13 entity of the public servant a thing of economic value to obtain advertisements or 14 other recognition featuring the public servant, immediate family member, or the legal 15 entity if: 16 (a) The public servant recuses or disqualifies himself on all matters 17 involving the transaction, if applicable. 18 (b) The terms and conditions of the transaction are the same as or 19 substantially similar to those available to similarly situated persons who are not 20 public servants or related persons. 21 (c) The transaction is conducted without preference and in the same manner 22 and subject to the same requirements and conditions applicable to the general public.

1	(d) The value of the transaction does not exceed ten thousand dollars.
2	However, no person shall enter into separate transactions valued at ten thousand
3	dollars or less as a subterfuge to avoid the limitation in this Subparagraph.

5	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
6	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
7	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
8	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
9	effective on the day following such approval.
