

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 54 (SB 95)**

**2024 Regular Session**

**Wheat**

Existing law provides that a person who takes possession of a strayed animal must notify the Livestock Brand Commission by certified mail return receipt requested.

Existing law provides that costs and expenses charged by a person holding a strayed animal will commence on the date the notice is mailed.

New law retains existing law and further provides that notice can be made by electronic submission through the department's website and expenses will commence on the date notice is electronically submitted.

Existing law provides that if the commission is unable to determine ownership within 10 days of receipt of the notice, the strayed animal will be advertised and sold in accordance with law.

New law retains existing law and clarifies that animals will be advertised and sold under R.S. 3:3006.

Effective May 15, 2024.
