<u>Prior law</u> (R.S. 18:586) provided that a state or local elected official who retires or resigns from office is ineligible to be appointed to succeed himself in the office from which he retired or resigned.

<u>Prior law</u> further provided that a state or local elected official who retires or resigns from office is ineligible to be a candidate for an election to fill the vacancy in the office resulting from his retirement or resignation.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and further provides that a state or local elected official who is removed from office is ineligible to fill the vacancy created by his removal unless the removal was due to a defect that is capable of being legally cured prior to qualifying for the election to fill the vacancy.
