Seabaugh

Prior law (R.S. 18:586) provided that a state or local elected official who retires or resigns from office is ineligible to be appointed to succeed himself in the office from which he retired or resigned.

Prior law further provided that a state or local elected official who retires or resigns from office is ineligible to be a candidate for an election to fill the vacancy in the office resulting from his retirement or resignation.

New law retains prior law and further provides that a state or local elected official who is removed from office is ineligible to fill the vacancy created by his removal unless the removal was due to a defect that is capable of being legally cured prior to qualifying for the election to fill the vacancy.
