**ACT 286 (SB 57)**

**2024 Regular Session**

**Lambert**

Existing law provides for powers and duties of the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists (board).

New law creates a new licensed psychological associate license issued by the board.

New law provides for qualifications and requirements for a person to receive the license.

New law establishes fees for application and licensure to be collected by the board.

New law provides certain discretion to the board in issuing the license.

New law provides for the scope of practice and limitations for licensed psychological associates.

New law provides for procedures for license renewal, denial, revocation, and suspension.

New law provides for privileged communications to a licensed psychological associate.

Effective August 1, 2024.
